## REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

### 2017 As-Needed Inspection/Testing/Survey

(Not to exceed 2 years)

The Midland County Road Commission is seeking professional services for inspection, testing, and survey for a variety projects. Projects may be added or deleted as needed. If your firm is interested in providing services, please indicate your interest by submitting a proposal.

Consultants and their sub-consultants shall be experienced in MDOT road construction inspecting, testing and survey. Submittal shall be limited to 1-2 pages of description of how the company can best provide services for Midland County Road Commission, then resumes of one or two certified technicians with MDOT construction inspection and testing experience that are proposed to provide assistance to the county on an as needed basis. Provide certification of training documentation including but not limited to: SESC, density, concrete, HMA, aggregate, etc. Also provide your firm's rate schedule for services associated with this proposal.

The following is a partial listing of anticipated projects based on current information, and is intended for informational purposes only:

- 130955 Eastman at Bombay Safety project
  - Construction scheduled April 3 thru Aug 4<sup>th</sup>, inspection/testing
- 128042& 119903 Freeland, Shearer, Pine River projects, inspection/testing
  - Construction scheduled Summer thru fall, inspection/testing
- Approximately 2 miles of road reconstruction
  - Inspection/testing
- Approximately 25 miles of road resurfacing
  - Inspection/testing
- Approximately 4 miles of Ultra Thin overlay
  - Inspection/testing

#### Additional Information

Each proposal shall be submitted via email or envelope. The submittal shall contain the details of the fee schedule to complete the items contained within the Scope of Services for this proposal request. Each envelope shall be labeled "**Midland County Road Commission – 2017 As-Needed Inspection/Testing/Survey**".

The Consultant/Consultants will be selected using a qualification based selection process. The selection team will review the information submitted and will select the two firms considered most qualified to perform the services based on the proposals. The selected Consultant/Consultants will be contacted to confirm capacity. Upon confirmation, negotiations will be conducted with the firm/firms selected.
