Eastman Road resurfacing and widening project has not been advertised yet, working on the final percentage estimates.

Coleman Road bridge over Chippewa River has been turned in and is being reviewed for advertising. The Road Commission will have to pay for the paving of School Road for a detour route.

The design for Freeland/Sasse Road roundabout will be completed soon.

Jeff stated he attended paser training and webinars last week for rating roads.

He attended the Michigan Road Preservation Association workshop in Mt. Pleasant last week. He attended a contract management workshop yesterday for Local Agency Projects.

Materials bids have been advertised and will be opened on March 25th.

He will be attending a bridge conference with Jon in a couple weeks.

He has started survey work on the local road projects for this summer.

The Monroe Road bridge deck was poured on Tuesday. Work should continue next week.

Redstone Road bridge beams have been installed and contractor is forming the walls.
